Subject: Continuation of Recognition of MBBS degree (150 seats) awarded by Mahatma Gandhi University of Medical Sciences & Technology, Jaipur, Rajasthan in respect of the students being trained at Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Hospital, Jaipur, Rajasthan.

Sir,

I am directed to say that your college was assessed by the Assessors appointed by MARB to conduct virtual assessment during the final MBBS practical Examination ON 10.03.2022. The report of physical assessment is not available with UGMEB. However, as per the decision taken in the Commission in its meeting held on 11.04.2023, in case infrastructural assessment as well as examination assessment have been carried out, the application for Recognition should be processed as per the regulation norms. In case only one assessment has been carried out, recognition is to be processed for only one year henceforth.

2. Accordingly, your college was considered for grant of Continuation of Recognition (only for one year) of MBBS degree (150 seats), awarded By Mahatma Gandhi University of Medical Sciences & Technology, Jaipur, Rajasthan. While evaluating the assessment reports alongwith the AEBAS and HMIS data including CCTV, the following deficiencies have been observed :

A. Deficiency in Faculty and Residents as observed on AEBAS record data submitted :

The faculty and Senior Resident Doctor deficiency is calculated on the basis of attendance of registered persons by the college on AEBAS records. The attendance of these faculty is ranging from zero to less than 50% of the total working days. Out of 382(for UG) (and 401 total) persons registered, 43 have zero attendance and 39 have less than 50% attendance.


3. After careful consideration, it has been decided in Undergraduate Medical Education Board (UGMEB) that Continuation of Recognition may be granted to the MBBS degree awarded by Mahatma Gandhi University of Medical Sciences & Technology, Jaipur, Rajasthan to 150 students at Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Hospital, Jaipur, Rajasthan with directions to the college authorities to fulfill all prevalent rules and regulations.

4. Accordingly, the approval of the competent authority in UGMEB is hereby conveyed for grant of **Continuation of Recognition for ONE YEAR** of MBBS degree for 150 students awarded by Mahatma Gandhi University of Medical Sciences & Technology, Jaipur, Rajasthan in respect of the students being trained at Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Hospital, Jaipur, Rajasthan.

5. You are also directed to fulfill all the deficiencies mentioned above and advised to apply afresh to UGMEB in 2024 for grant of Continuation of Recognition for 150 MBBS seats, at least six (6) months prior to the final examination of MBBS Part-II (Practical) alongwith the requisite fee i.e. Rs.3.54 lakhs only.

6. This issues with the approval of President, UGMEB.
