Reservation statement of MGUMST in Admissions/Employments

1. Mahatma Gandhi University of Medical Sciences & Technology, Jaipur has been established vide :
 - i) Ordinance No. 4 of 2011 (Made and promulgated by the Governor on the 23rd day of May, 2011), notified in the Rajasthan Gazette dated May 24, 2011 vide Notification No. F.4(4) Vidhi/2/2011 dated May 24, 2011 by the Principal Secretary to the Government, Law (Legislative Drafting) Department (Group-II), Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur.
 - ii) Act No. 22 of 2011 notified in the Rajasthan Gazette dated September 15, 2011 vide Notification No. F.2(32) Vidhi/2/2011 dated September 15, 2011 by the Principal Secretary to the Government, Law (Legislative Drafting) Department (Group-II) Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur.
2. MGUMST is unaided self-financing private university. It does not receive any 'Grant in aid' from Central/State Government.
3. As per Section 32(3) of the MGUMST Act, Reservation in admission to the University for scheduled castes, scheduled tribes, backward classes, special backward classes, women and handicapped persons is provided as per the policy of the State Government.
4. Information regarding admissions on the reserved seats is sent regularly to the State Government and uploaded on AISHE portal.
5. Being unaided self-financing private university, Reservation in employments is not applicable to the MGUMST.

Ordinance

to provide for establishment and incorporation of the Mahatma Gandhi University of Medical Sciences and Technology, Jaipur in the State of Rajasthan and matters connected therewith and incidental thereto.

Whereas, with a view to keep pace with the rapid development in all spheres of knowledge in the world and the country, it is essential to create world level modern research and study facilities in the State to provide state of the art educational facilities to the youth at their door steps so that they can make out of them human resources compatible to liberalized economic and social order of the world;

And whereas, rapid advancement in knowledge and changing requirements of human resources makes it essential that a resourceful and quick and responsive system of educational research and development be created which can work with

regulations, consistent with this Act and the rules, Statutes and the Ordinances made thereunder, for the conduct of their own business and that of the committees appointed by them.

32. Admissions.- (1) Admission in the University shall be made strictly on the basis of merit.

(2) Merit for admission in the University may be determined either on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the qualifying examination and achievements in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities or on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the entrance test conducted at the State level either by an association of the universities conducting similar courses or by any agency of the State:

Provided that admission in professional and technical courses shall be made only through entrance test.

(3) Reservation in admission to the University for scheduled castes, scheduled tribes, backward classes, special backward classes, women and handicapped persons shall be provided as per the policy of the State Government.

33. Fee structure.- (1) The University may, from time to time, prepare its fees structure and sent it for approval of the committee constituted for the purpose.

(2) The committee shall consider the fees structure prepared by the University and if it is satisfied that the proposed fees is-

(a) sufficient for :-

(i) generating resources for meeting the recurring expenditure of the University; and

(ii) the savings required for the further development of the University; and

(b) not unreasonably excessive.

it may approve the fees structure.

(3) The fees structure approved by the committee under sub-section (2) shall remain in force for three years and the University shall be entitled to charge fees in accordance with such fees structure.

CHAPTER - V**Admission and Fee Structure**

46. Admissions.- (1) Admission in any course of the University shall be made as per the provisions of section 32 of the Act and law prevailing at the time of admission.

(2) Admission in the University shall be made strictly on the basis of merit.

(3) Merit for admission in the University may be determined either on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the qualifying examination and achievements in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities or on the basis of marks grade obtained in the entrance test conducted at the State level either by an association of the universities conducting similar courses or by any agency of the State:

Provided that admission in professional and technical courses shall be made only through entrance test.

(4) The University shall adhere to the criteria of reservation in admission as per the policy of the State Government, from time to time.

47. Fee Structure. - (1) The University shall, charge fee for various programmes of study in accordance with the provisions of section 33 of the Act.

(2) The University may revise its fee-structure from time to time in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

CHAPTER - VI**Miscellaneous**

48. Conferment of Honorary Degrees.- (1) The University may confer the honour of Doctor of Science (D.Sc.), Doctor of Literature (D.Lit.), Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) etc. on the distinguished persons for their contribution and high attainments. The President shall submit his / her recommendation for such

The NEET 2016 has been conducted for 85% seats in Govt. Medical/Dental colleges of Rajasthan and 85% seats in Private Medical/Dental Colleges who have opted to fill the seats in the respective colleges through Rajasthan State UG Admission (Medical & Dental) Board 2016, as per the rules and regulations laid down by RUHS and Govt. of Rajasthan.

The NEET score along with some relevant data has been provided by the NEET 2016 to the Rajasthan State UG Admission (Medical & Dental) Board 2016.

The on-line allotments will be done by the Admission Board comprising of all Principals of Medical/Dental Colleges of the state that have opted for the same.

During the process, the eligibility criteria, relevant documents, etc. of the candidates shall be verified and Medical/Dental College shall be allotted to the candidate according to the merit, the choice(s) filled by the candidate and availability of the seats as per the reservation policy of the state.

- III. All those students who are bonafide residents of Rajasthan but are studying in other states will also be eligible for the allotment process.
- IV. The candidate is son/daughter of serving or retired (I) Employee of Government of Rajasthan (II) Officer of All Indian Services borne on State Cadres of Rajasthan and has served for more than 3 years with State Government.
- V. The candidate is son/daughter of serving or retired, permanent employee of Govt. Undertaking/Corporation/Improvement Trust/ Municipal Bodies/ Council/ Panchayat Samiti/ Co-operative bodies, duly constituted by the Government of Rajasthan by an act of Law who has put in at least 3 years of service on the last date of submission of the on-line registration form (State quota) in the year of admission.
- VI. The candidate is son/daughter of serving/retired, permanent employee of any of the State University or Secondary Board of Education (Rajasthan) provided that employee has worked in Rajasthan for 3 years preceding the last date of submission of the on-line registration form (State quota).
- VII. Candidate is a natural son/daughter of a Serving/Retired permanent employee of Indian Defense and the employee is of Rajasthan origin irrespective of his place of posting. Provided that in case of Defense Personnel from Rajasthan origin, a certificate has to be submitted by them from the employer to the effect that his state of origin is Rajasthan at the time of his entry into service. Eligible candidates of this category shall be admitted as per laid down criteria of priority cum merit of the Rajasthan MBBS & BDS Admissions - 2016.
- VIII. Candidate is a natural son/daughter of a Serving permanent employee of Indian Defense and the employee is posted in Rajasthan at the time of last date of submission of the on-line registration form (State quota) for admission.
- IX. Candidate is a son/daughter of serving/Retired person of Para-Military Forces of India and the employee is of Rajasthan origin, irrespective of his place of posting. Provided that in case of Para-Military personal from the Rajasthan origin, a certificate (certificate Proforma 3) has to be submitted by them from the employer to the effect that his state of origin is Rajasthan at the time of his entry into service.
- X. Candidate is a son/daughter of serving person of Para-Military Forces of India and the employee is posted in Rajasthan at the time of last date of submission of the on-line registration form (State quota) for admission (certificate Proforma 4).
- xi. Candidate is a son/daughter of a Judge of Rajasthan High Court subject to the condition that he/she submits an undertaking/affidavit stating that such benefit is not being claimed or availed by them in any other State.

4. RESERVATION

- (a) 15% of the seats in Govt. Colleges will be reserved in MBBS/BDS Course to be filled up on all India basis conducted by DGHS.
- (b) Out of total 24 seats, 4 in each State Medical College of Rajasthan of MBBS Course will be reserved for candidates selected under the Central Government pool. The Central Government Authority will fill up these seats.

Note: The remaining seats shall be treated as the State Seats and will be filled up on merit cum-preference in Rajasthan MBBS & BDS Admissions 2016 with following reservations: -

cc (c) (i) 16% seats, after excluding the seats of sub-clause (a), (b) above are reserved for natural born (not adopted) candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-1. Not less than 25% out of the above reserved seats shall be reserved from girl candidates belonging to Schedule Caste.

ST (ii) 12% seats, after excluding the seats of sub-clauses (a), (b) above are reserved for natural born (not adopted) candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-1. Not less than 25% out of the above reserved seats will be reserved from girl candidates belonging to Schedule Tribe. 45% of ST seats are to be for ST candidates who are bonafide residents of scheduled area (tribal area).

OK (iii) 21% seats, after excluding the seats of sub-clauses (a), (b) above are reserved for those belonging to Other Backward Classes as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-1. Not less than 25%, out of the above reserved seats shall be reserved from girl candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes. Candidate must submit OBC Certificate issued by competent authority in Rajasthan State (issued on or after 27.08.2015 and clearly indicating 'Non Creamy Layer').

Note: The candidates from Jat community from Bharatpur and Dholpur are not considered under OBC NCL category.

SBC (iv) 5% seats, after excluding the seats of sub-clauses (a), (b) above are reserved for those belonging to Special Backward Classes as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-1. Not less than 25%, out of the above reserved seats shall be reserved from girl candidates belonging to Special Backward Classes. Candidate must submit SBC Certificate issued by competent authority in Rajasthan State (issued on or after 27.08.2015 and clearly indicating 'Non Creamy Layer').

(d) 1% seats after excluding the seats of sub clauses (a), (b) are reserved on priority cum merit for the natural born (not adopted) sons/daughters of Defence personnel (serving /Retired) of Rajasthan Origin, and para-military personnel (serving / retired) of Rajasthan origin, horizontally. 50% out of these reserved seats shall be reserved for girls, unfilled seats will be reverted back to boys category.

Priority order for Defence personnel of Rajasthan origin, in consultation with Director, State Soldier Welfare Board Rajasthan, will be as follows:-

1. Widows/Wards of Defence Personnel killed in action. (Certificate Proforma 1 and 2A)
2. Wards of those Disabled in action and boarded out from service/died while in service with death attributable to military service / disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service.(Certificate Proforma 1 and 2A)
3. Widows/Wards of Gallantry Award winners.(Certificate Proforma 2C)
4. Widows/wards of ex-service men.(Certificate Proforma 2B)

- (e) In case of private medical/ dental colleges, the reservation of seats will be according to the orders of the State government.
- (f) 3% seats out of each category of 16% (SC), 12% (ST), 21% (OBC), 5% (SBC) and remaining General Category shall be further reserved on Merit-cum-Priority in each category horizontally for DISABLED candidates having permanent disability as per MCI and Govt. of Rajasthan rules. The Certificate regarding permanent Physical Disability including the percentage, issued by a Medical Board of Govt. Medical Colleges duly constituted by the Central/State government will only be considered. The UG Admission Board will finally confirm the % of disability by a Medical Board at the time of physical verification.(Certificate Proforma 5)

Note:

Persons with disabilities (Equal opportunities, Protection of Rights and full participation) Act, 1995 and notification No. S.O. 107 (a), dated February 7, 1996 issued from the Ministry of Welfare and published in Gazette of India, Ex.-Ordinary Part. II, Sec. 3(III) dated 7-02-1996 page 1 by which under clause 2 of Chapter I definitions as (i) Disability means (i) Blindness; (ii) low vision; (iii) Leprosy cured; (iv) hearing impairment; (v) Locomotors disability; (vi) Mental retardation; (vii) Mental illness.

As per Medical Council of India vide No. MCI-34 (1)/ 2003/ Med/ 11773 dated 14-07-2003 and endorsed by Govt. of Rajasthan vide P-5/2 ME/Gr.-1/99 dated 30-07-2003 & P. 6(2) ME/1/2001 dated 18-01-2005 and MCI amended notification No. MCI- 34 (41)/ 2008 med./ 54469 date 25-03-2009:

1. The persons who are visually handicapped and hearing disabled should be deleted from this category and they should not be considered for admission in MBBS courses.
2. Only persons with locomotors disability of lower limbs between 50% to 70% should be allowed the benefit or reservation under the Disability Act for admission in the medicine courses. This condition shall apply to admission in all medicine courses for reserved seats. The candidates having locomotor disability of upper limb will not be allowed the benefit of disability act.

Provided that in case any seat in this 3% quota remains unfilled on account of unavailability of candidates with locomotors disability between 50% to 70% then any such unfilled seat in this 3% quota shall be filled up by persons with locomotors disability of lower limits between 40% to 50% before they are included in the annual sanctioned seats for General Category candidates.

3. The valid disability certificate of the candidate from a Medical Board certified by the State Government in various Govt. medical colleges will be considered and should not be more than 3 months old from the date of submitting this application for seeking admission in the reserved category for disabled candidates.
4. The Candidates who have got themselves examined in the Medical Board constituted for 15% All India Seats through NEET 2016 by the authorized Medical Board will bring the certificate issued to them for physical verification

All the allotments will be done by the Admission Board constituted by the State Govt. comprising of all Principals of Medical/Dental Colleges of the state .

During the process, the eligibility criteria, relevant documents, etc. of the candidates shall be verified and Medical/Dental College shall be allotted to the candidate according to the merit, the choice(s) filled by the candidate and availability of the seats as per the reservation policy of the state.

- VIII. Candidate is a natural son/daughter of a Serving permanent employee of Indian Defense and the employee is posted in Rajasthan at the time of last date of submission of the on-line registration form for admission, or
- IX. Candidate is a son/daughter of serving/Retired person of Para-Military Forces of India and the employee is of Rajasthan origin, irrespective of his place of posting. 3A. ELIGIBILITY FOR ROLL BACK SEATS FROM ALL INDIA QUOTA

As per Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 09.05.2017, the roll back seats after second round of counseling of All India quota will be filled from the NEET qualified candidates from the All India Merit list only. Candidate who wishes to participate on these seats can also register himself/herself before 20th July 2017.

Note: - The remaining seats shall be treated as the State Seats and will be filled up on merit cum-preference in Rajasthan MBBS & BDS Admissions 2017 with following reservations: -

- sc (c) (i) 16% seats, after excluding the seats of sub- clause (a), (b) above are reserved for natural born (not adopted) candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-1. Not less than 25% out of the above reserved seats shall be filled from girl candidates belonging to Schedule Caste.

- (ii) 12% seats, after excluding the seats of sub-clauses (a), (b) above are reserved for natural born (not adopted) candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe as notified in the Presidential Order for the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill conditions as laid down in Clause-1. Not less than 25% out of the above reserved seats shall be filled from girl candidates belonging to Schedule Tribe.

45% of ST seats are to be for ST candidates who are bonafide residents of scheduled area (tribal area), not less than 25% out of the these seats shall be filled from girl candidates belonging to Scheduled area (tribal area).

2. Wards of personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service **(Certificate Proforma 1 and 2A)**
3. Widows/ Wards of defence personnel who died while in service with death attributable to military services. **(Certificate Proforma 1 and 2A)**
4. Wards of those disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military services **(Certificate Proforma 1 and 2A)**
5. Wards of Ex-servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Award **(Certificate Proforma 2B and 2C)**
6. Wards of Ex-servicemen **(Certificate Proforma 2B)**

- (e) 5% seats out of each category of 16% (SC), 12% (ST), 21% (OBC), 5% (MBC) and remaining General category shall be further reserved on Merit-cum-Priority in each category horizontally for candidates with specified disabilities (PwD) under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and in accordance with Appendix H-1 of Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997 of MCI **(Annexure 1)**. The "Certificate of Disability" issued in accordance with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017 will only be considered. The UG Admission Board will finally verify the certificate of disability by a Medical Board at the time of physical verification as per MCI norms.

The Candidates who have got themselves examined in the Medical Board constituted for 15% All India Seats through NEET 2019 by the authorized Medical Board, will bring the certificate issued to them on the notified date for physical verification.

- (f) No reservation will apply on NRI seats of all Medical/Dental Colleges.

For admission under NRI Quota in Medical/ Dental courses in the colleges in the State of Rajasthan, priority shall be given to the NRI with ancestral background of the State of Rajasthan by own/parents/Grandparents resided in State of Rajasthan at least for a period of 5 years at any time. The proof of residence will also be applicable for the consideration priority for NRI Quota, for which document (Electricity/ Water bill/ Documents of immovable property/ Indian Passport/ Ration Card/ Voter ID/ Aadhaar Card etc.) to the effect for this criteria is required to be submitted by ward of NRI (including PIO/ OCI).

Firstly allotments of NRI Quota seats shall be allotted to candidate having ancestral background of the State of Rajasthan by own/parents/Grandparents resided in State of Rajasthan at least for a period of 5 years. Later on remaining Vacant NRI seats will be allotted/ filled by the candidates of NRI belonging to other states.

For PIO / OCI: Overseas Citizens of India (OCI), Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) are allowed for admission under NRI Quota.

If student is taken as a ward by some other nearest relative [as mentioned below (i) to (v)] such students also may be considered for admission provided the guardian has bonafidely treated the student as a ward. For this following nearest relative (NRI) of candidate, who should be ordinarily residing abroad as an NRI can only be considered:
- Real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle and real aunt.

- (iv) 5% seats, after excluding the seats of sub-clauses (a), (b) above are reserved for those belonging to More Backward Classes NCL (MBC NCL) of the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill other relevant conditions. **Candidate must submit MBC Certificate for Rajasthan State issued by competent authority of Rajasthan (issued on or after 17.10.2019 and clearly indicating 'Non Creamy Layer')**.
- (v) 10% seats, after excluding the seats of sub-clauses (a), (b) above are reserved for those belonging to Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) of the State of Rajasthan and who fulfill other relevant conditions. **Candidate must submit EWS Certificate for Rajasthan State issued by competent authority of Rajasthan (valid for financial year 2020-21)**.
- (d) Not less than 25%, out of each category of SC, ST, STA, OBC-NCL, MBC-NCL, EWS and unreserved category shall be filled from female candidates.

7. Wives of (i) defence personnel killed in action and boarded out from service (ii) defence personnel disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military services (iii) ex-servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Award
8. Wards of serving personnel
9. Wives of serving personnel

As per the Kendriya Sainik Kalyan Board, the para-military seat is admissible for only one member of the family. Only wards of Para-military personnel from serial 1 to 9 below are eligible for the scheme.

Priority order for Para-military personnel of Rajasthan origin, in consultation with Director, State Soldier Welfare Board Rajasthan, will be as follows:-

9. Wives of serving personnel

(f) 5% seats out of each category of 16% (SC), 12% (ST), 21% (OBC), 5% (MBC), 10% EWS and the remaining shall be further reserved on Merit-cum-Priority in each category horizontally for candidates with specified disabilities (PwD) under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and in accordance with Appendix H-1 of Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997 of MCI (**Annexure 1**).
